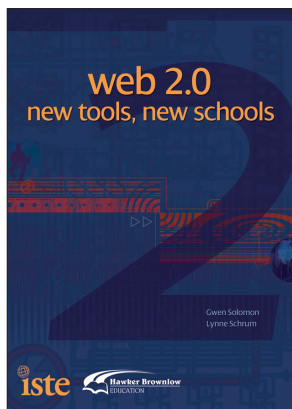


web 2.0: new tools, new schools
