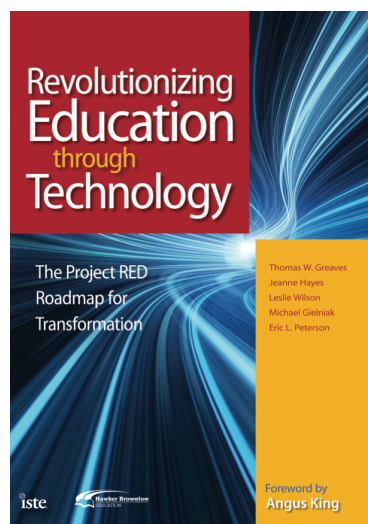


Revolutionizing Education through Technology: The Project RED Roadmap for Transformation
