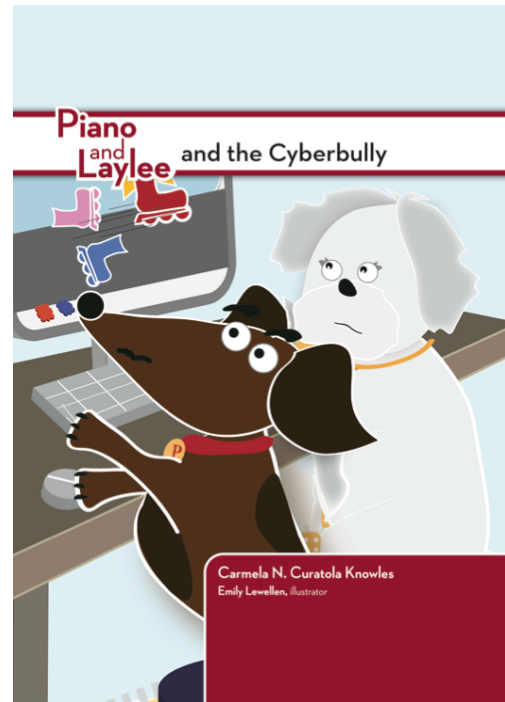


Piano and Laylee and the Cyberbully
