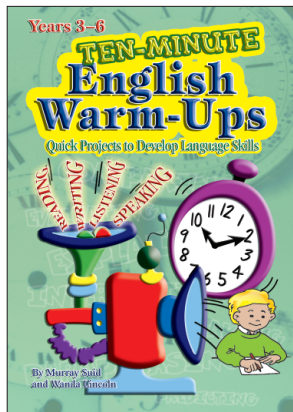

Secondly, skill-building practices in the English classroom must be “whole”. The practices provided for students should integrate all aspects of the English language. They also should build on the strengths students bring to the activities, so that as students learn the basics, they also use language joyfully. And finally, quick skill practices, if done regularly and tied to the English process, can produce big results. To paraphrase the tortoise, short and steady wins the race.
