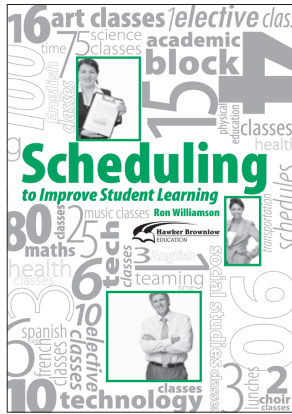


# Scheduling to Improve Student Learning
