15. The second tube on the left holds **azure** paint.

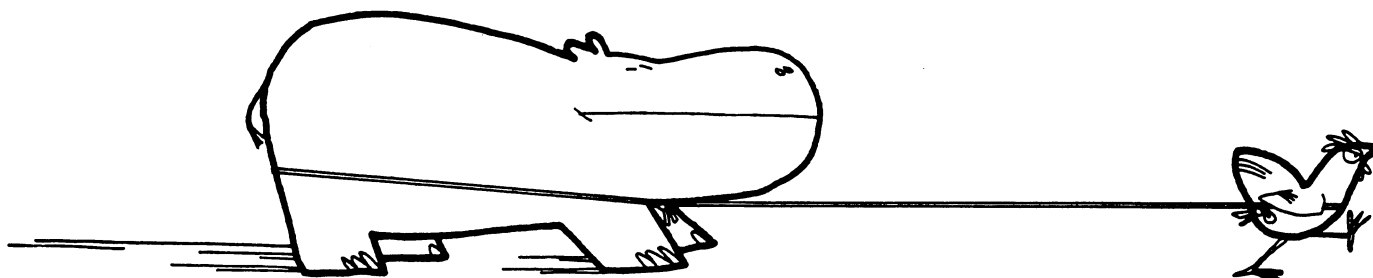
Answer: If you have followed the directions correctly, the color names will be in alphabetical order.
