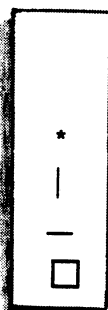

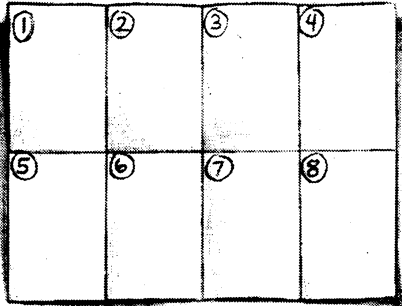
DO WHAT I SAY

Your teacher often gives instructions on how to organize your paper. It is as important to follow these directions as it is to know the right answer.

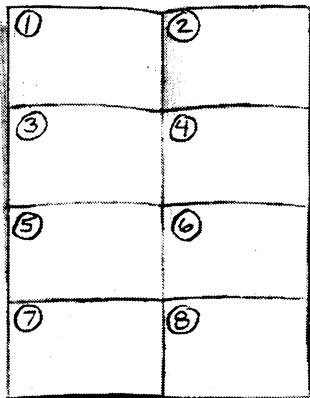
Read each set of directions. Below each one there are three pictures. Find the one picture that shows the task correctly done. On the line, write the name of the student who followed all the directions.

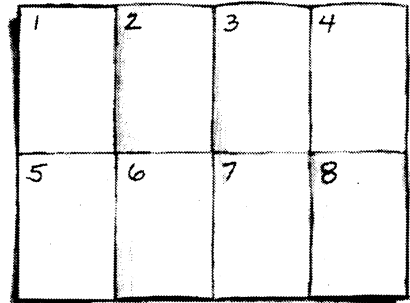

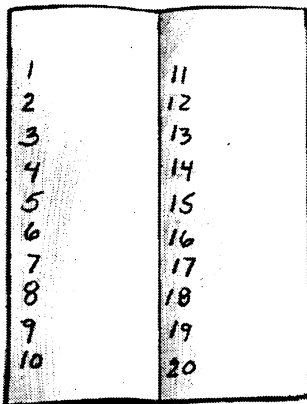

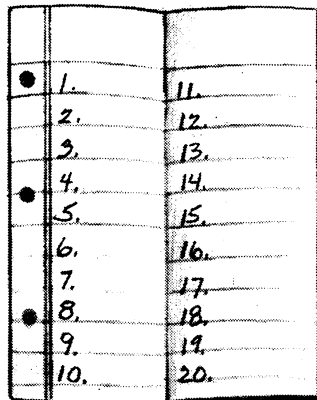

2. Fold a piece of lined paper in half vertically. Number from one to ten on one side, and from eleven to twenty on the other. Put a period after each number.

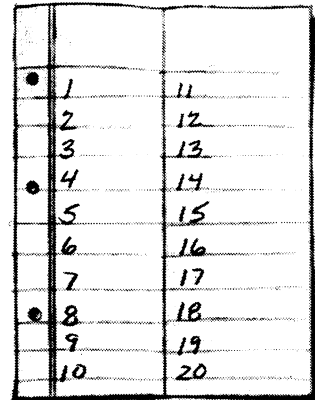
