

# Australia Day Ship Decoration

## Materials

Pattern (pages 7-8)

22 x 22 cm coloured paper

Scissors

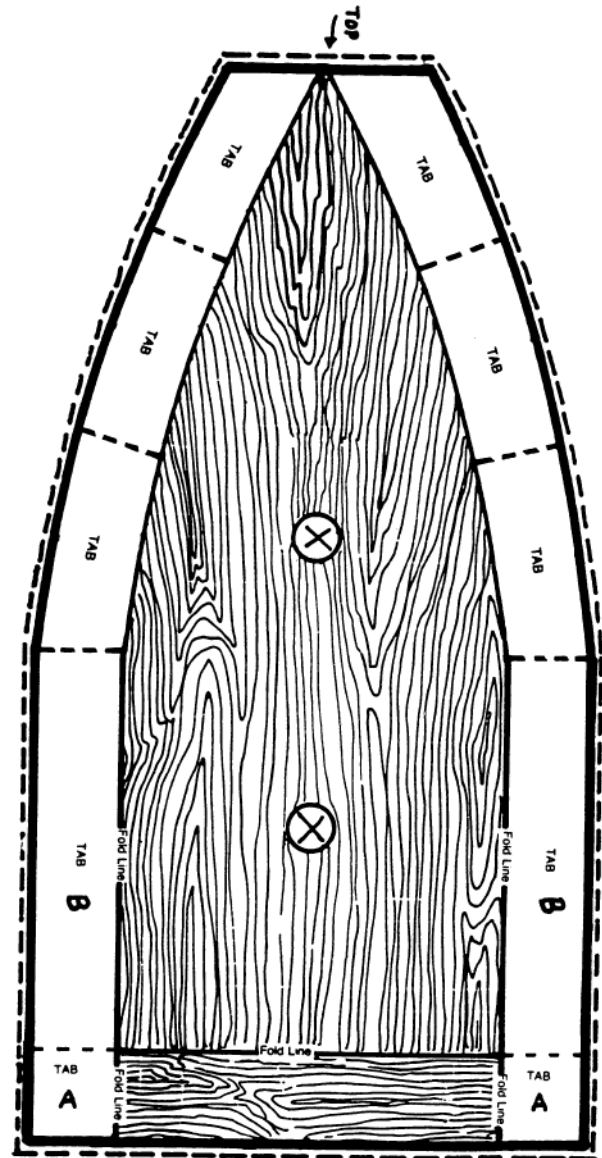
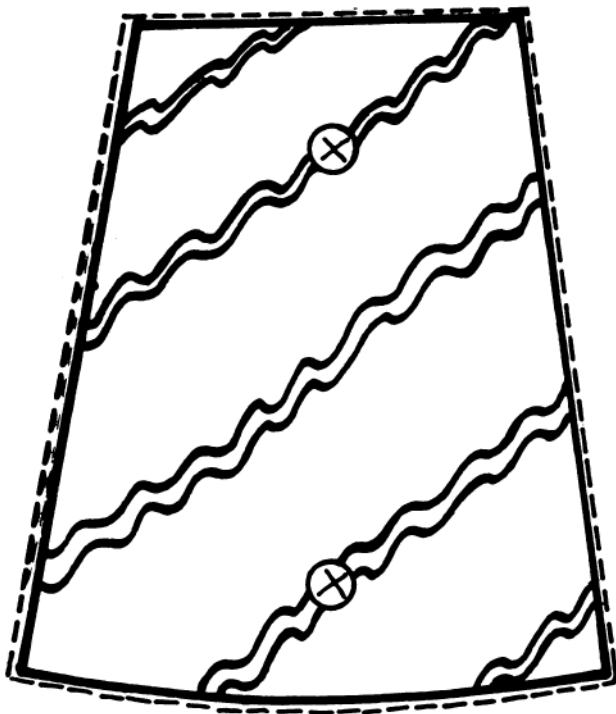
Glue or glue stick

Crayons or coloured pencils

One 15 cm plastic straw

One 20 cm plastic straw

Hole punch



## Procedure

1. Copy, colour and cut out patterns.
2. Punch out holes on patterns as indicated by X's.
3. Cut along dotted lines on deck pattern.
4. Fold deck pattern along folds.
5. Glue A tabs to B Tabs.
6. Apply glue to Tabs and fasten as shown.
7. Weave a straw through holes in each flag. Insert each straw into a hole in the deck.

# Easter-Egg Hunt Doorknob Hanger

## Materials

Pattern

14 x 26 cm coloured  
paper

Scissors

Crayons or coloured  
pencils



## Procedure

1. Copy, colour and cut out pattern.
2. Cut along dotted lines on pattern.
3. Fill in the blanks.
4. Slip hanger over a doorknob.

# Anzac Day

## Materials

Pattern

10 x 10 cm red paper

5 x 5 cm black paper

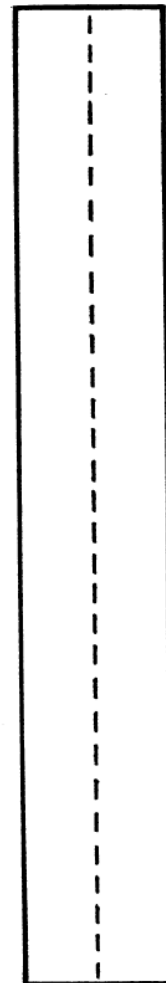
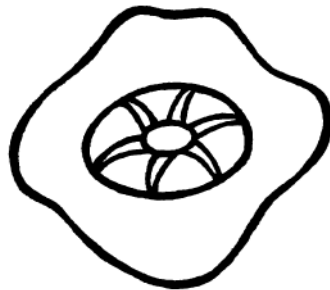
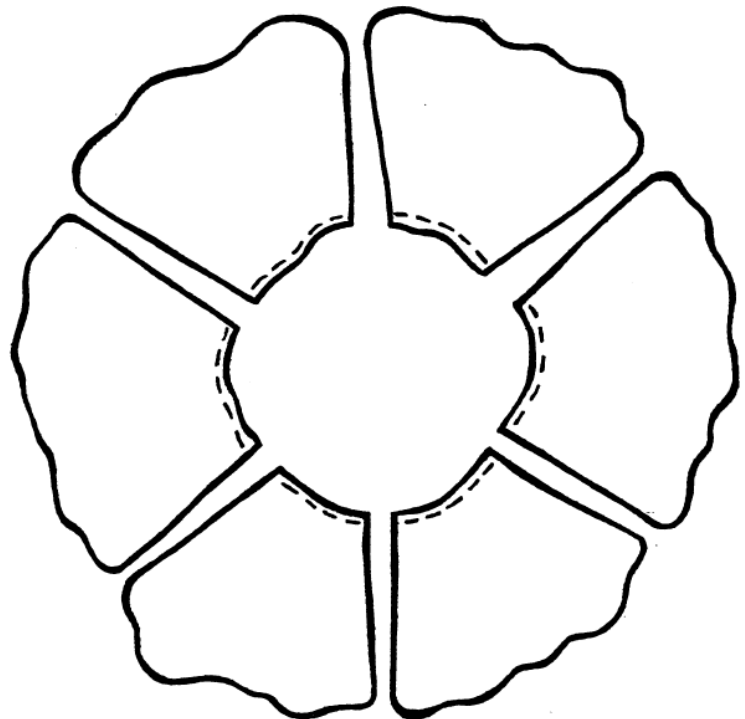
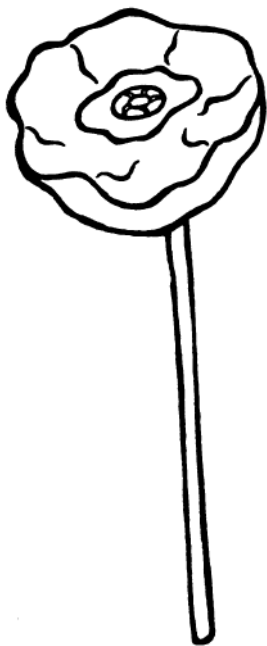
2 x 13 cm green paper

Scissors

Glue or glue stick

Safety pins

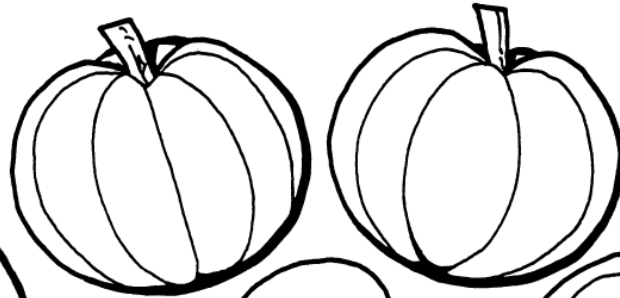
Stapler



## Procedure

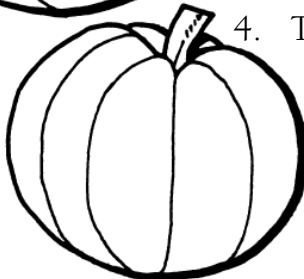
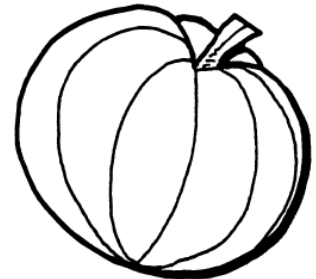
1. Copy and cut out pattern.  
Red paper – petals  
Black paper – stamen  
Green paper – stem
2. Glue petals together along dotted lines.
3. Glue stamen to centre of petals.
4. Fold stem and glue the two halves together.
5. Glue or staple the stem to the back of the poppy.
6. Use safety pins to pin the poppies to children's shirts or jumpers.

# Pumpkin Power

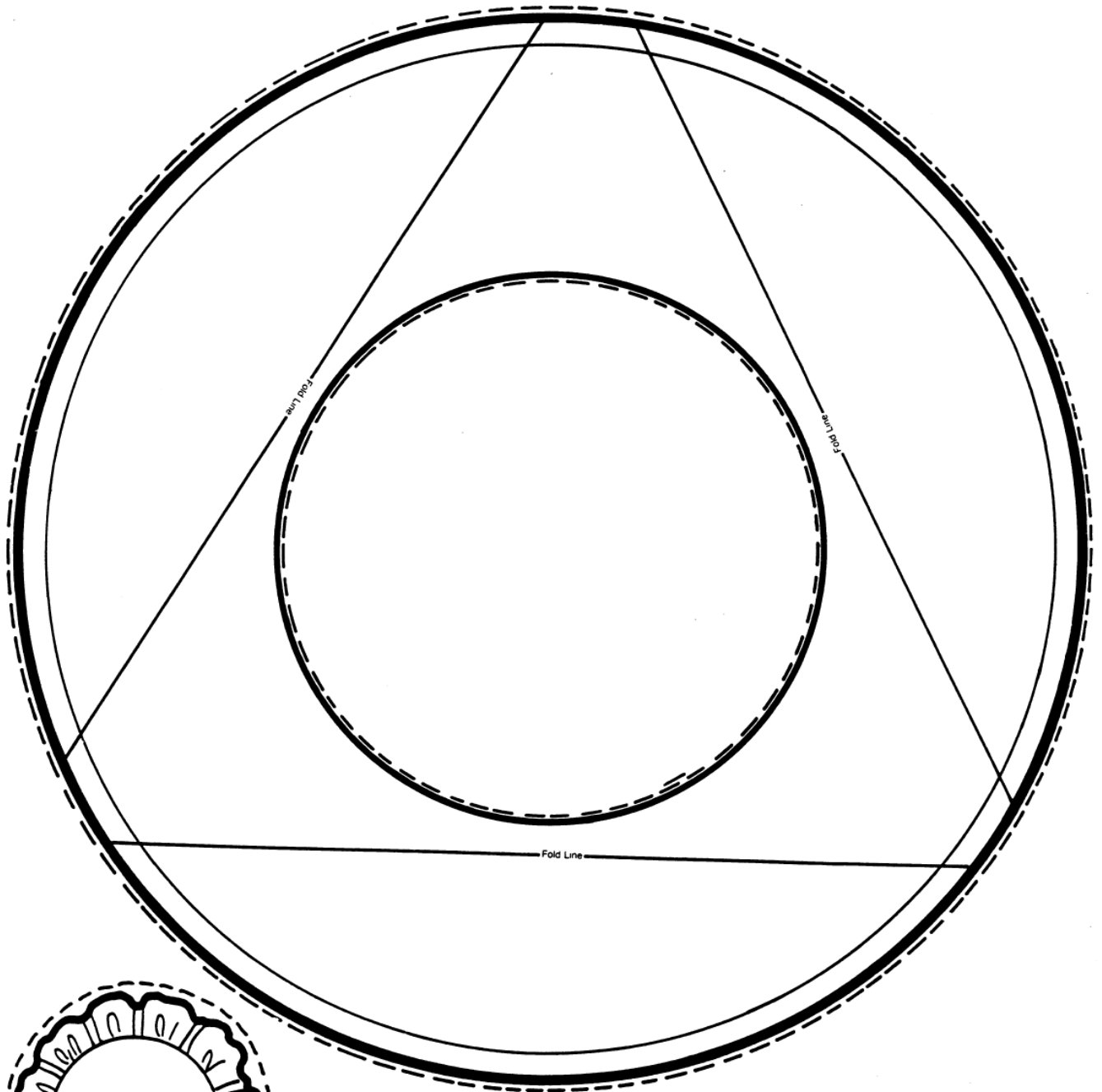


## Directions

1. In turn, draw a card and give the answer.
2. Check the answer.
3. If correct, flip a coin.  
Heads: move 1 space.

# Father Christmas

## Materials

Coloured paper:

30 x 30 cm main shape

15 x 24 cm face

22 x 30 cm beard, hat trim, hat tassle  
and moustache

5 x 5 cm nose

7 x 10 cm curls

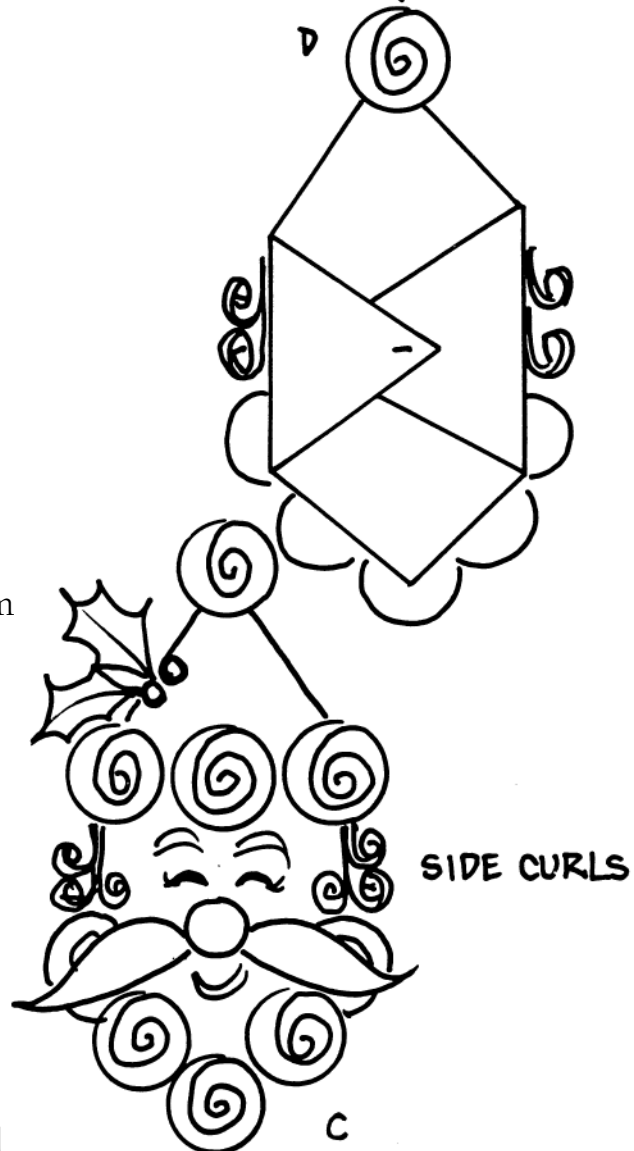
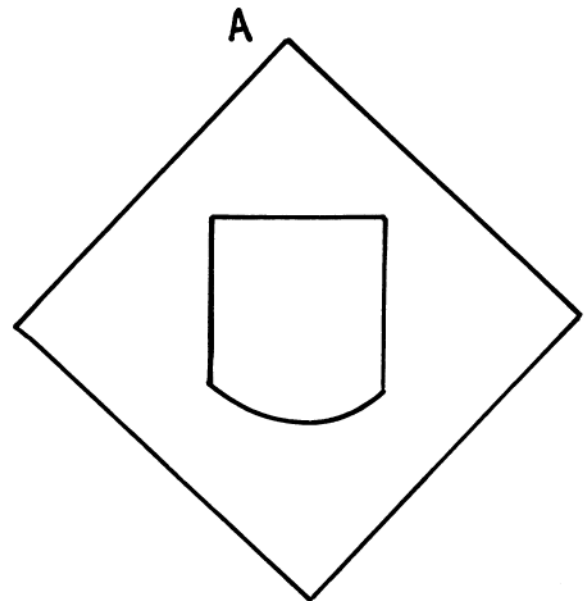
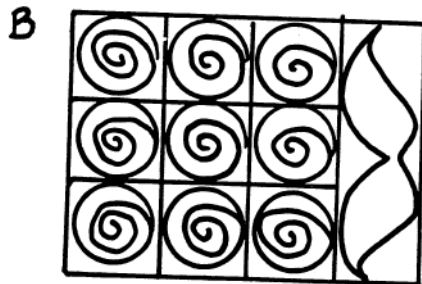
2 pieces 5 x 10 cm holly leaves

Scissors

Glue

Stapler

Felt-tip pen



## Procedure

1. Round off two corners of 15 x 15 cm paper for face and glue on 30 x 30 cm paper (figure A).
2. Cut out nine 8 cm spirals for beard, hat trim and hat tassle. Draw and cut out moustache (figure B).
3. Cut out 5 cm circle for nose.
4. Cut out six 1.5 cm strips for side curls. Curl the strips.
5. Glue all pieces in place as shown (figure C).
6. Draw in eyes, brows and mouth with felt-tip pen.
7. Staple points together at back of head as shown (figure D).
