

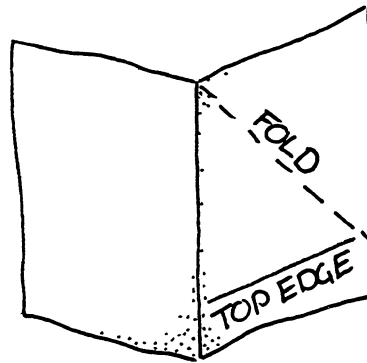

A Recycled Christmas Tree

Materials:

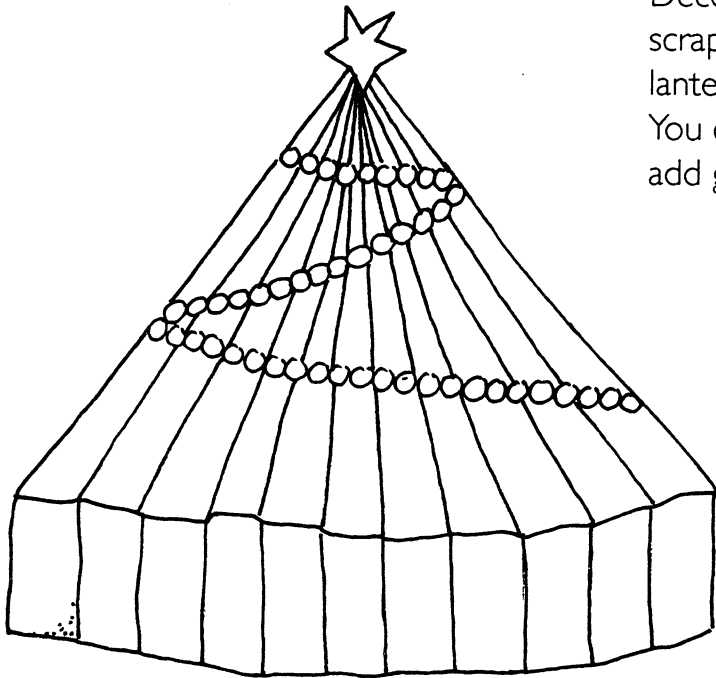
an old magazine – eg. "Women's Weekly"
scraps of coloured paper
tin foil

The Christmas tree is formed by folding down the cover and each page of the magazine. Take the top right hand corner of each page and fold it in and down so that the top edge of the page runs along the centre fold of the magazine.



Repeat this for every page of the magazine as well as the cover.

Now fasten the two covers together with a paper clip so that the pages form a cone shape.

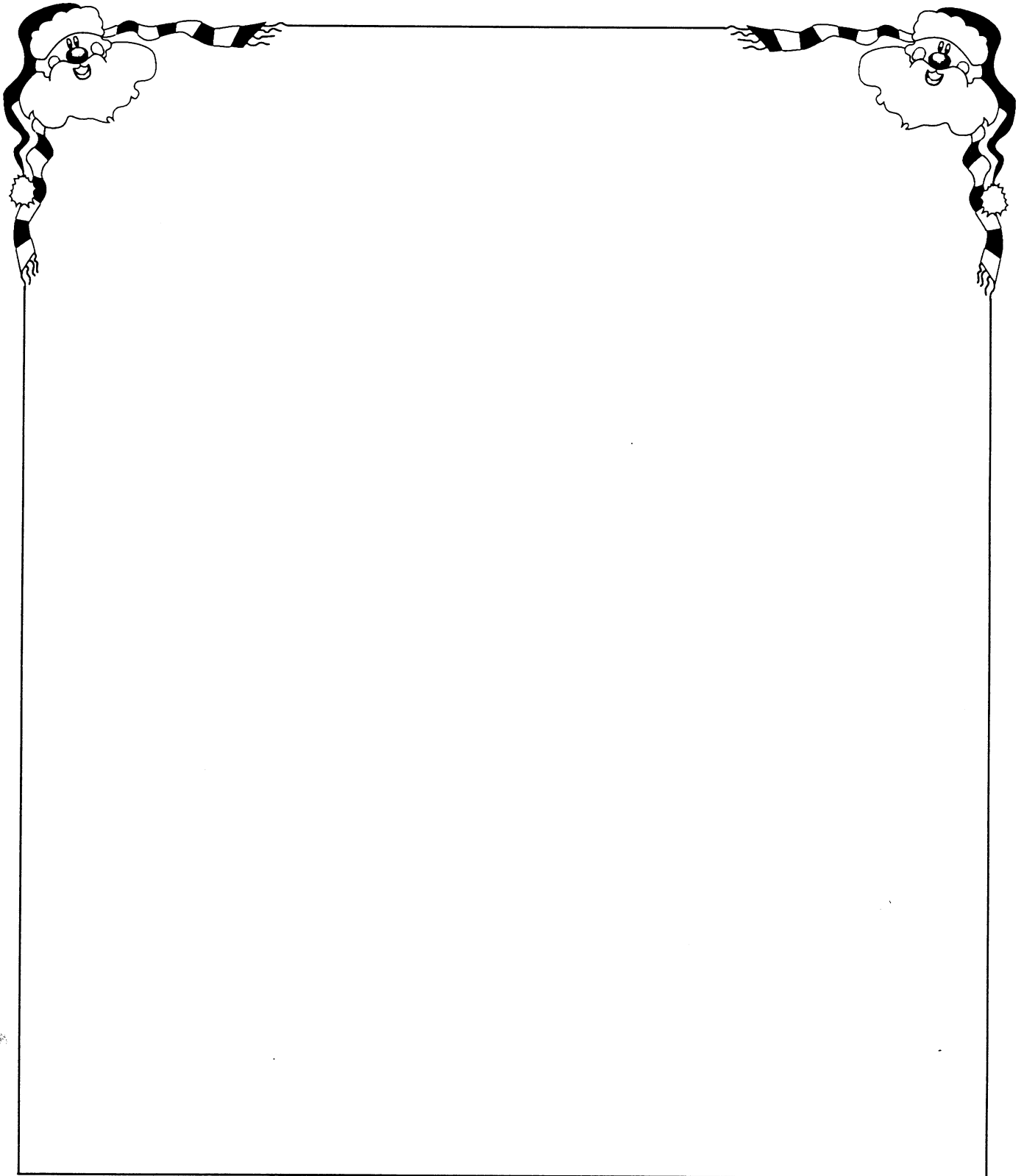


Decorate with miniature chains made from scraps of coloured paper. Make miniature lanterns and add a star to the top of the tree. You can place glue along the page folds and add glitter before you decorate.
