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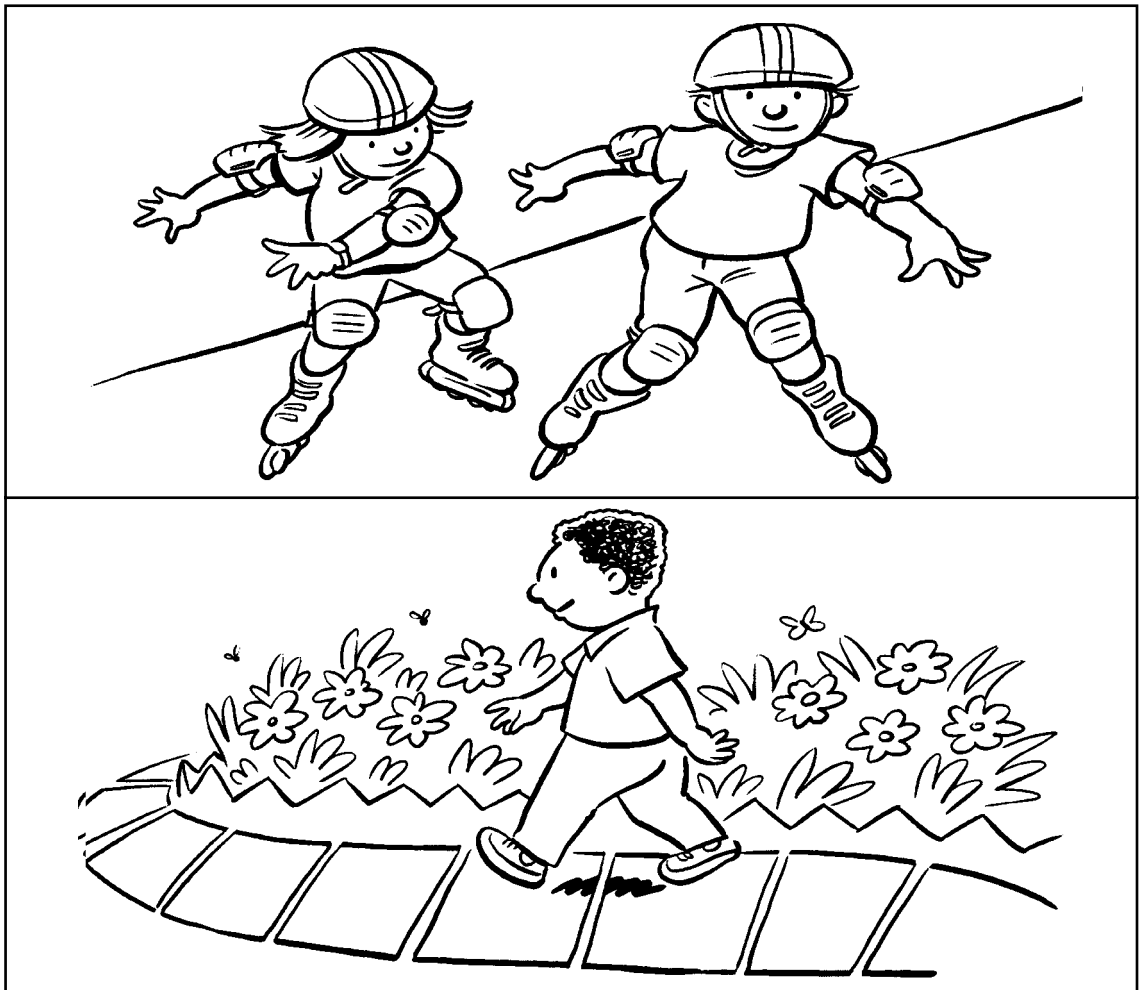
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Time Flies

Colour the picture from each pair that shows time when it feels fast.







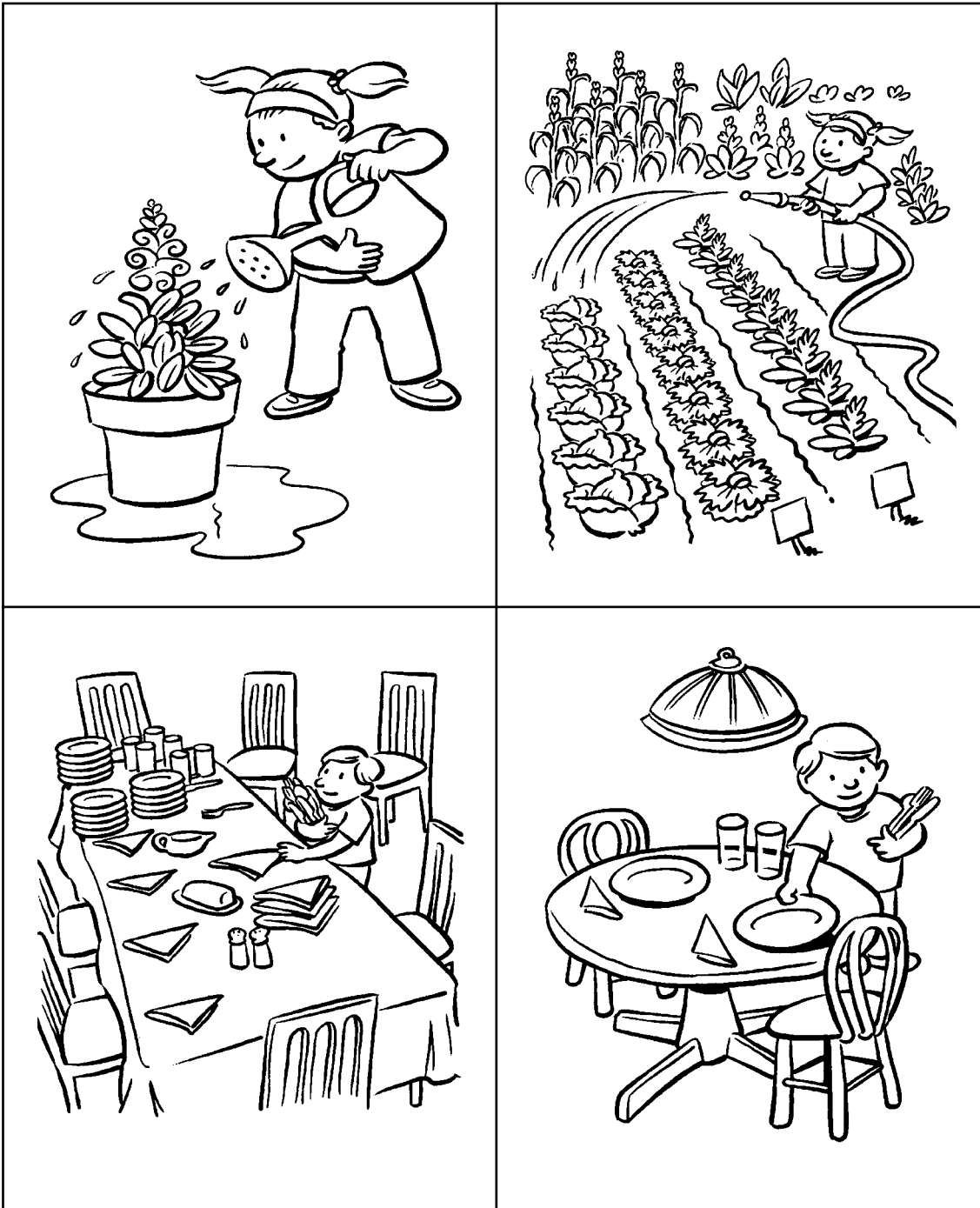
Time for Tasks!

time to more



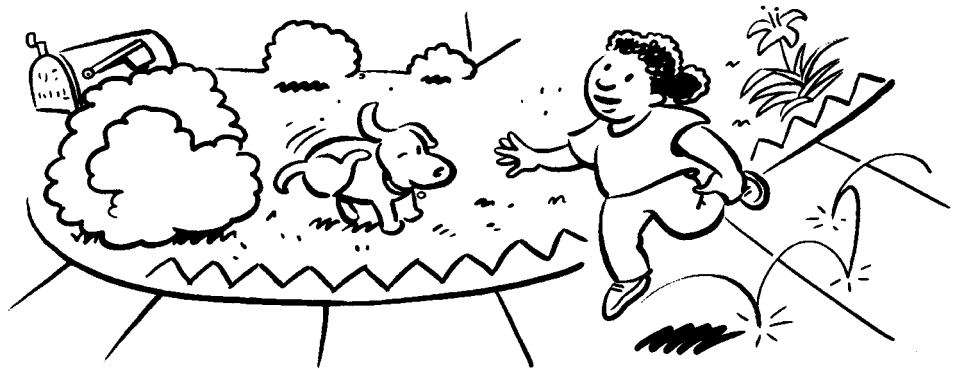


Meet a Minute!
