Fresh As Spring



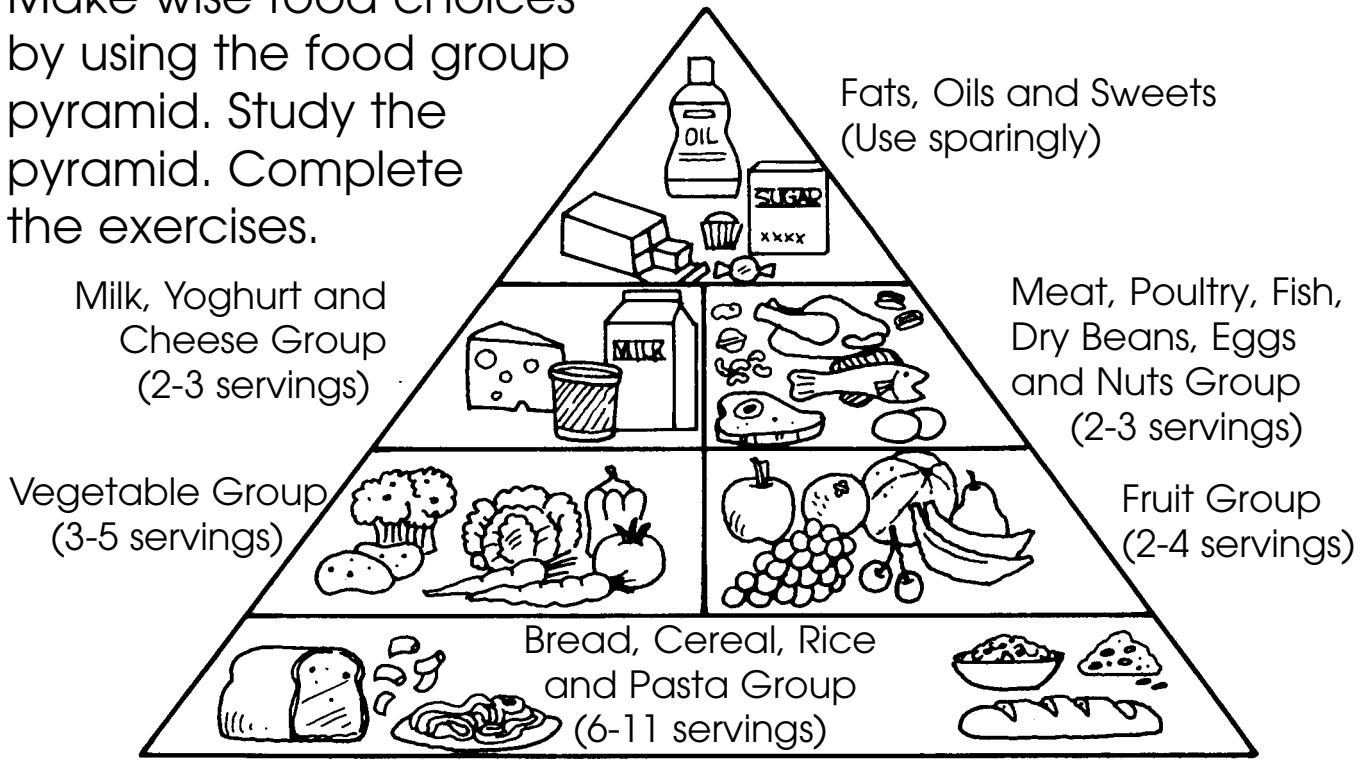
