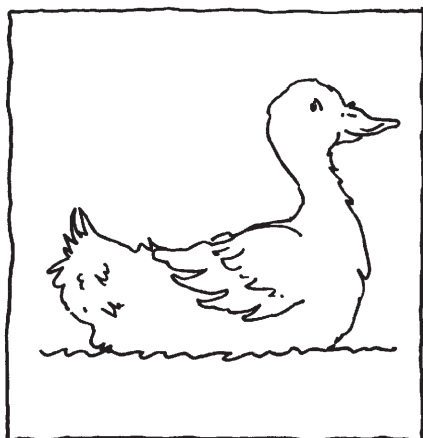
Preparation Directions:
