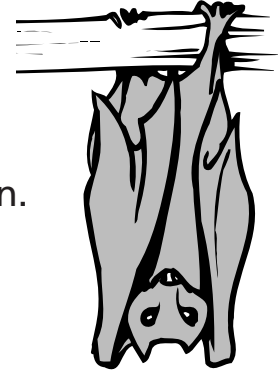


Animals: BATS

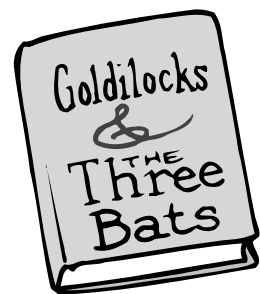
Draw a picture of bats hanging in a hollow tree. Write one of the facts you learned on each bat.

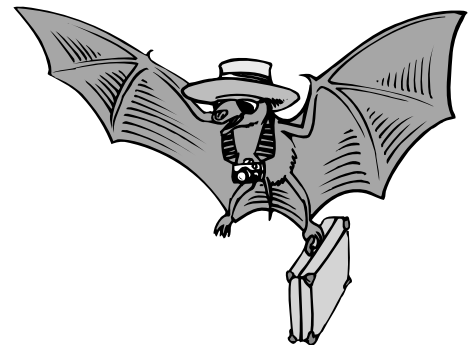
Inside your bat picture, write a recipe for a fruit salad that a bat might enjoy.

Try this:

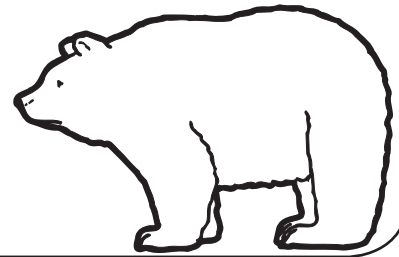
