PREDICTING

When I predict, I:

Guess	Infer	Believe
Estimate	Speculate	Forecast
Assume	Suspect	Project

Prediction Questions / Statements:

- What do you think will happen?
 - What clues tell you what will happen?
 - What will the author do or tell you next?
 - What clues from the passage help you remember what has happened?
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QUESTIONING

When I question, I:

Search	Doubt	Ask
Explore	Investigate	Inquire
Challenge	Probe	Quarrel with
Dispute	Examine	Seek information

Questioning Questions / Statements:

- What questions do you have about the topic?
- Share what you think the author meant when ...
- What did you think about as you read?
- Can you give another example for ... ?
- What else do you know about this subject?





CLARIFYING

When I clarify, I:

Explain
Reread
Solve

Monitor
Refine
Simplify

Define
Sharpen
Remember

Clarifying Questions / Statements:

- I need help understanding this part of the section.
- Words I don't know or understand are ...
- Discuss and write down what the words mean.
- Use different words to figure out the meaning.
- Read ahead or reread to figure out the meaning.
- Add another example to figure out the meaning.



VISUALISING

When I visualise, I:

Imagine
Picture

See
Pretend

Dream
Envision

Visualising Questions / Statements:

- When I read this, I image that ...
- As I read, in my mind I see ...
- The picture I am making is ...
- As I read, I make movies about ...



SUMMARISING

When I summarise, I:

Sum up
Conclude
Judge

Surmise
Decide

Rundown
Organise

Determine Pull together Tie together

Summarising Questions / Statements:

- Tell me about what you just read.
- What clues from the passage helped you organise your thinking?
- What is the most important part of the story?
- What are a couple of sentences that sum up the meaning of the entire passage?

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
