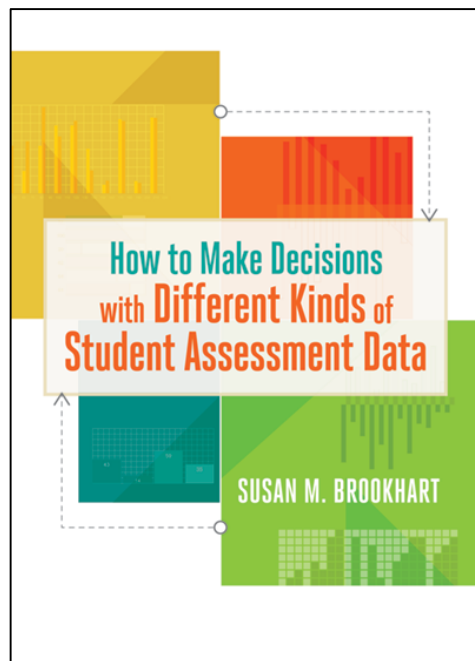


# How to Make Decisions with Different Kinds of Student Assessment Data
