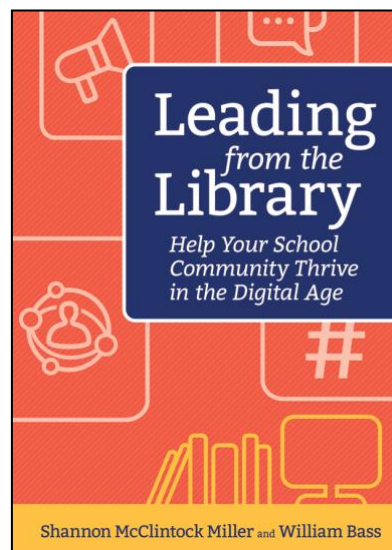


# Leading from the Library: Help Your School Community Thrive in the Digital Age
