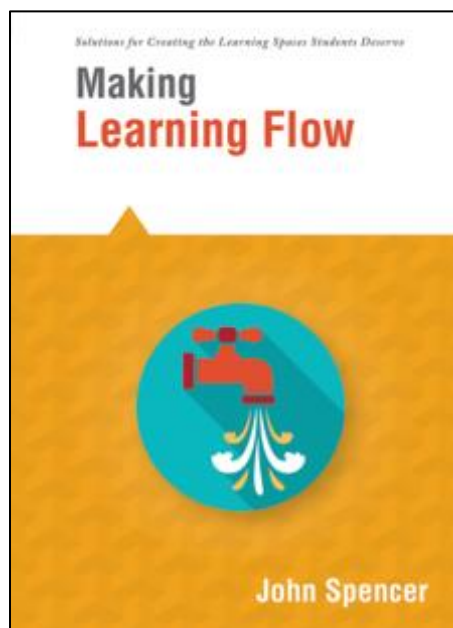

Summary

Traditional schooling methods tend to value students compliance over student engagement.
