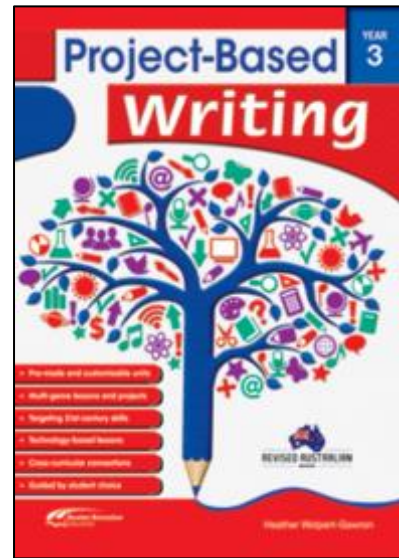


Project-Based Writing: Year 3
