Ⓓ 15 April

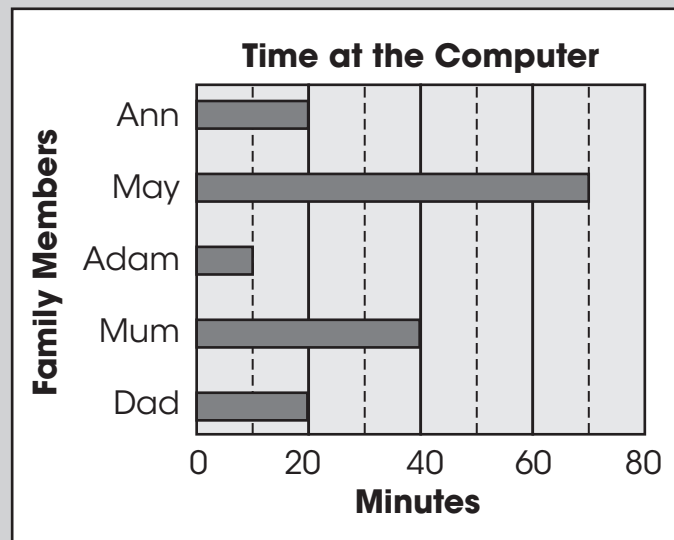
This is not correct. The number 15 is the third Tuesday in April.
