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What is the constant? The constant is intelligence. No matter what information our students will deal with, they will be more successful if they can think about that information in many ways - use multiple intelligences. So if we are not teaching in many ways, stimulating the range of intelligences, we are not preparing our students for their journey.

In preparing students for the future, we are drawn into new ways of teaching. The structures provide an easy way for us to engage and develop the range of intelligences, to prepare students for their journey into an unknown future.
